 - Parents must wait at the school gate and the pupils will be brought to the gate by members of staff.
- Breakfast Club 8:15-8:30am entrance via Heol-y-Frehines.
- If your child is poorly and is not going to be in school, please inform Miss Jury prior to the school day commencing. If we don't know where your child is, a phone call / text home will be made. If we fail to make contact, there will be a home visit made.
- For Safeguarding reasons parents/carers/visitors should not enter the school building unless they go through the main door and are met by a member of staff.
- Ensure your child's clothing is labelled with their name. We already have lots of items left in school that nobody has claimed.


