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Criw Cymraeg-

Criw Cymraeg help promote a Welsh culture in our school. In assemblies we do some Welsh quizzes about famous people and even famous foods such as Welsh Cakes as well as popular singers such as Tom Jones! Criw Cymraeg present these assemblies and give out Siaradwr yr Wythnos/Welsh speaker of the week certificates.

Teaching and Learning Committee-

In Teaching and Learning we are promoting new concepts in our classrooms such as the silent solo and turn & talk. These help us become better learners! We are also going to start learning British sign language every Friday. We also make sure that everyone gets a say in what activities we could do as part of our next topics.

Rights Committee-

In the rights committee we teach the rights of every child that they are entitled to in school and outside of school. We will be designing posters to explain what each right means and supporting assemblies in our classrooms so we can teach our classes the right of the week!

Playground Leaders-

As part of Playground Leaders we look after the playground equipment and we make sure all the equipment is put out on the yard and collected safely so all pupils get the chance to play with it. We also make sure that everybody has somebody to play with and be with at all times unless they want to be alone.

Digital Leaders-

We look after ICT equipment, introducing new apps to classes for children to express themselves in new ways they want to work. We support the teachers in assembly with ICT e.g. helping with Power points and music.

Eco Committee -

At Eco Committee we make sure that the school is following the reduce-reuse-recycle motto by recycling our rubbish in the correct bins. We also promote looking after the environment by using posters to remind staff and pupils to turn off the lights and computers etc and looking after our forest area.
